COVID-19 VACCINE INFORMATION

City of Dallas Employees have multiple options for obtaining a COVID-19 vaccination. **There are many ways to locate a COVID-19 vaccine in Texas** and the resources below are not the only options. Employees can and should pursue other COVID-19 vaccine scheduling systems around the state, including contacting their personal physician or primary care provider.

CareATC Clinic

Only available to City of Dallas Employees. Availability is dependent on several factors including the state's vaccine allotments and the eligibility of the population we serve. To apply for a vaccine appointment, please [visit this link](#) and complete the pre-registration process.

Vaccination Hubs

People eligible for a vaccine do not have to live in those counties to be vaccinated at a hub. The rules for registration at local hubs vary by city and county. Some local hubs limit registration to groups that are currently eligible for vaccination. Each hub also decides who to vaccinate from their waitlists. Consult the website for each hub or call ahead for more information.
