Minimum Requirements for Promotion

CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD –

Senior Fire Prevention Officer: Fire Prevention Officers who have **completed two (2) years of service as a fire prevention officer, and are not on probation for any reason**, shall be eligible to test for promotion to Senior Fire Prevention Officer. Therefore, those who meet the eligibility requirement by **August 5, 2025**, may compete on this examination (Civil Service Rules – Rule 4, Section 4.4 (a) (7)).

Application to take the Written Examination

All eligible candidates wishing to take this examination must submit a promotional application. The link to the application can be found on the City of Dallas Internal Positions Employment Opportunities webpage at:

Application Window:

- Application open: Wednesday, May 7, 2025
- Application closes: Friday, June 6, 2025 at 11:59pm

Candidates who fail to submit an application by the deadline will not be permitted to take this examination.

Upon successful registration through the NEOGOV system, you will receive an automated email confirmation at the address listed on your application. Additionally, on June 20, 2025, you will receive an email notification from the Civil Service Department regarding your eligibility status.

Candidate Check-in Process

- Check-in Time: Begins at 9:30 a.m.
- Required Identification: A City of Dallas or government-issued photo ID is mandatory for entry into the exam room. Failure to present the required ID before entering the room will result in denial of admission to the examination.
- Prohibited Items:
 - Electronic or communication devices (e.g., body cameras, cell phones, pagers, laptops, tablets, smartwatches, Bluetooth devices).
 - Personal belongings, including study materials, large purses, backpacks, water bottles, and earplugs.
 - Personal writing utensils (all necessary materials will be provided).

If you bring a communication device, you will be asked to return it to your car, and you will still be subject to the check-in time. Once the testing process begins, possession of any communication device or other prohibited item will result in your disqualification.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

Once the exam room doors are closed, **NO CANDIDATES** will be allowed to enter the exam room.

Senior Fire Prevention Officer Promotional Process

This promotional process consists of a multiple-choice knowledge examination and will cover relevant knowledge areas from the source list attached (**Appendix A**).

Candidates must pass the written examination to be eligible for promotion.

The multiple-choice examination will contribute **100%** to a candidate's overall promotional score.

Additional information regarding the written exam will be provided in the **Written Exam Orientation Manual** and accompanying **video**, which will be distributed by June 20, 2025. Candidate questions regarding material in the orientation manual or video must be submitted **in writing** to civilserviceinfo@dallas.gov by **4:00 p.m. on June 30, 2025**.

Candidates requiring accommodation under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) for the written examination must submit a written request to the Civil Service Department at civilserviceinfo@dallas.gov by Monday, July 7, 2025.
