Condition: Excellent

Significance: Probably none-altered.



No. 2 - 2512 Thomas

Approx. 1890-95;

Description: Late Victorian, 2 story, main roof-steep hip, intersecting gables, bay pavilions, Ionic porch columns, 2 story Ionic columns at center, fishscale shingles at gable ends, transom side and corner lights, interior chimney, tall 1/1, 2/1 windows, wood porch.

Condition: Excellent.



No. 3 - 2516 Thomas

Approx. 1890-1900;

Description: Late Victorian, main hip roof, gable with bay pavilion, 2 story, wrap porch with hip roof and Doric columns on brick piers, hip dormer, interior chimney, transom, tall 1/1 windows with cornice window heads; Condition: excellent.



No. 4 - 2600 Thomas

Approx. 1890-1900;

Description: 2 story, tall, narrow 1/1 windows, Doric style porch columns, covered with siding.

Condition: Good.



<u>No. 5 - 2612 Thomas</u>

Approx. 1890-1900;

Description: 2 story, Craftsman, 1/1, 2/1 windows, 1/1 paired dormer windows, addn. on front, metal awnings added.

Condition: Good.



No. 6 - 2616 Thomas

Approx. 1880-90;

Description: Vernacular Victorian, $1-\frac{1}{2}$ story, wood frame, steep pitched gable roof, 1/1 windows, 1/1 paired dormer windows; turned porch posts.

Condition: Excellent.

Approx. 1890-1900;

Description: Victorian cottage planbook, steep hip roof with shortridge, intersecting gable, large gable dormer, side chimney, gable end trim, 1/1 windows, wide trim boards.

Approx. 1950-60; Description: shallow gable roof, smaller front gable projection, boxed extended eaves, beige brick, grillwork porch posts, bowed large 25

pane front windows. Condition: excellent.

Significance: None - too new.

Description: layered hip roof, interior chimney, large picture windows, medium color brick.
