SUBJECT Reauthorization of Public/Private Partnership Program Guidelines and Criteria

On December 3, 2018, the Economic Development and Housing Committee will consider the reauthorization of the current Public/Private Partnership Program Guidelines and Criteria for the period of January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019.

Summary

The Property Redevelopment and Tax Abatement Act (Texas Tax Code, Chapter 312) requires that any city desiring to enter into tax abatement agreements as an incentive to foster private investment must first establish guidelines and criteria governing tax abatement agreements and must pass a resolution stating that it elects to be eligible to participate in a tax abatement agreement. The Dallas City Council approved the current Guidelines on December 14, 2016, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-1984. The current Guidelines are effective through December 31, 2018.

Background

The Office of Economic Development is developing a new strategic plan, which will inform the development of new policies to amend or replace the Guidelines. The strategic plan is estimated to be complete in the first quarter of 2019 and revised or replacement policies will follow soon thereafter. While that process is ongoing, staff recommends extending the current policies for a period beginning on January 1, 2019 and ending on June 30, 2019 to allow sufficient time for completion of the strategic plan and drafting, review, and approval of new policies.

The existing guidelines were drafted with the assistance of the City Attorney's Office.

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of an item authorizing to extend the current Public/Private Partnership Program Guidelines and Criteria for the period of January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019.
